**Hotel:** Hotel spaces are in high demand, so be sure to book early

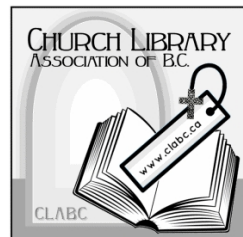
